ABOUT MCOBA



The Malay College Old Boys Association (MCOBA) has been in existence, in one form or another, and it all began in 1929; 24 years after the Malay Residential School (later known as the Malay College Kuala Kangsar) opened its doors to the first group of students.

The school hall was the historic place, where the Old Boys unanimously agreed to form The Malay College Old Boys Association (MCOBA) on the 16th March 1929. Raja Musa bin Raja Bhot (1910–1914), was elected as its founder president. A distinguished gentleman of great personal ability, he later became the country's first Malay Judge.

The MCOBA file at the Registrar of Societies states that in 1955, the President was Tunku Yaakob ibni Almarhum Sultan Abdul Hamid (1912-1918) and the Vice President was Dato' Ahmad bin Osman (1913-1919). Indeed, it was this Committee who were instrumental in organizing the Grand Jubilee Dinner of 1955.

One of the most significant milestones for MCOBA was the construction of 'Bangunan MCOBA', which currently houses the MCOBA Secretariat.

MCOBA has been successful through the years because individuals of so many different talents and abilities have found a common ground to share together. That common ground is simply an undying love for an old boyhood experience, which turned us into men.

MCOBA LOGO



The shield is quartered, coloured white in the first quarter, red in the second, yellow in the third and black in the fourth.

The colours represent the four houses into which the Malay College Old Boys are grouped: Idris (white), Sulaiman (red), Mohd Shah (yellow) and Ahmad (black).

In the middle of the shield is a red *kris*, a traditional Malay dagger. On top of the crest is a head of a tiger which is the symbol of the Federation of Malaya. Surrounding the left and right side of the shield are laurel wreaths symbolizing excellence.

The word MCOBA in the yellow ribbon stands for the Malay College Old Boys Association.

CORPORATE IDENTITY

In this variation, the logo is locked up as a stack with a white backdrop. This is our official face, and should be used whenever we are speaking as an organisation to our audiences.

Usage

- All official applications where MCOBA is represented as an organisation or legal entity. Examples: Business cards, stationery, official documents, corporate presentations.
- Staff & members materials. Examples: Staff identification card, membership card, uniforms.
- Any application with permanent presence. Examples: Vehicles, offices and industrial environments, signage.
- When functioning as an endorsement.
 Examples: Product packaging, sponsorship.

Official name and usage

Our official singular name is **MCOBA**. The name should always be spelled in uppercase to emphasize our gravitas and historic roots. The full legal name **Malay College Old Boys Association** should only be used for legal matters and information. It should never be used for branding and communication purposes.

CORPORATE IDENTITY

Structure

The logo always sits in a white box with NO keyline (outline/border). The white box ensures the logo is readable and prominent.

This lock-up is a single unit. It should not be separated or altered in applications.

The proportions and alignments as illustrated here are fixed and should not be altered or modified in anyway.

Always use the correct logo files available from the MCOBA Communication & ICT. Do not recreate or scan the artwork from this document.



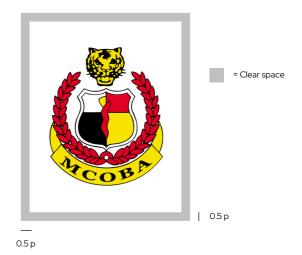
Clear space

Clear space refers to the area around the logo. It should remain clear of visual clutter.

Whenever possible, the clear space should be increased. It must never be decreased and no other elements should be positioned within this space.

When an image is used, the logo must always remain in the foreground.

Example of usage: Put the logo within the paragraph.



Minimum size

A minimum size has been set for the logo.

This is to ensure visibility of the logo.

INCORRECT USAGE

Do not distort it by stretching it vertically or horizontally.





Do not use another typeface.





Do not angle or rotate the logo.





Do not mirror the elements.





Do not apply graphic effects or add a keyline to the logo.





Do not use another colour or add texture.





Do not change the colour arrangement.





Do not reposition the symbol and logotype.





Do not reduce the logo to a size that interferes with the legibility.





Do not place the logo on an image background that interferes with the legibility.





Do not create glow effect on the logo.





Do not place the logo on a heavy textured background.

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ARRANGEMENT OF COLOURS



The arrangement of colours must follow the clockwise rotation. Which ever colour starts must be followed by next colour as in the image above.

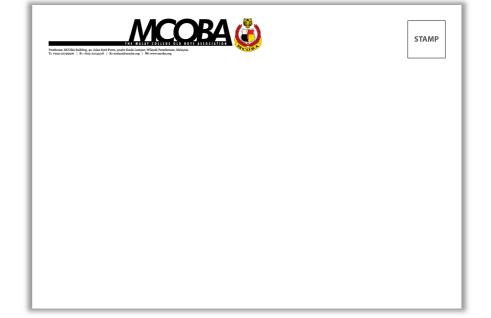

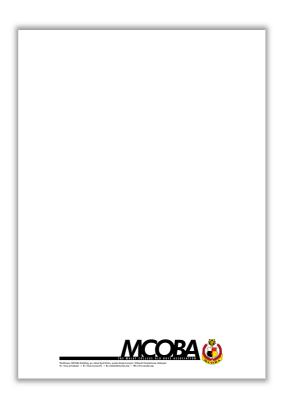

Note:

With the car sticker, care must be taken to ensure that the logo is centered accordingly.



Bunting

Size

Bunting: 3 ft (W) x 6 ft (H)

Corporate Flag

Information Counter

The logo must always be in a prominent position. It should be placed above the information counter.
